

Announcement of enrolment in the 1st grade for the school year 2024/2025

In accordance with Section 46(1) of Act No. 561/2004 Coll., the Act on Pre-School, Primary, Secondary, Higher Vocational and Other Education (Education Act), and in accordance with Act No. 500/2004 (Administrative Code) and Section 3a, paragraphs 1, 2, 6, 7 and 8 of Decree No. 48/2005 on Primary Education, as amended, the Director of the Mateřské školy a základní školy Beehive, s.r.o. announces enrollment in the 1st grade of the primary school for the school year 2024/2025.

Enrolment in Year 1

will take place on Saturday 6 April, 2024, at 9.00 a.m.

Course of enrolment

Enrolment will take the form of a play day where children will work together and with teachers in small groups .

There we will focus on social adaptability, check readiness for compulsory schooling (as per Czech law) and identify each student's level of English language skill.

Criteria for admission

a) Consistency of parents' expectations with the school's educational strategies

To determine the consistency of the educational strategies of the school and the family, a motivational interview will be conducted with the parents of the enrolled child prior to the enrolment date. The appropriateness of the educational strategies used for the child will also be taken into account when evaluating this criterion.

b) Level of English language proficiency

c) Additional criteria:

- The child's sibling is a student at a Beehive preschool or elementary school,
- The child has attended Beehive preschool.

Issuance of the admission/non-admission decision _____

The decision shall be issued by the Head of School without delay, within 15 days of the start of the administrative procedure.

The decision on admission or non-admission shall be issued in two copies, one of which shall be placed in the child's file and kept at the school administration, the other copy shall be sent to the child's legal guardians by post in their own hands.

The legal guardians of the child may appeal against the decision of the headteacher within 15 days from the day following the date of delivery.

The capacity of Year 1 for the school year 2024/25 is 18 students.

Issuance of a decision to postpone compulsory school attendance _____

The decision on the deferment of school attendance is issued by the headmistress, no later than 30 days after the initiation of the administrative procedure.

If the necessary documents are missing, the headteacher shall suspend the administrative procedure until all the documents necessary to authorise the deferment have been provided.

If the child is granted a postponement of compulsory schooling, the child's legal guardians shall be informed of the child's pre-school education obligation and the possible ways of fulfilling it.

If a deferral is requested, a written request from the child's legal guardians must be accompanied by a recommendation assessment, pursuant to Education Act No. 561/2004 Coll., Section 37(1), from:

- a school counselling centre (pedagogical-psychological counselling centre, pedagogical centre, etc.)
- a specialist doctor (e.g. paediatrician, speech therapist, etc.) or a clinical psychologist

At the same time, a completed application for deferment of compulsory school attendance must be handed in at the enrolment desk along with the legal guardian's ID card and the child's birth certificate.
